Navigating Virtual Hearings



Cleveland Housing Court implemented its virtual courtroom in June of 2020. Virtual Hearings allow case parties, attorneys/representatives, witnesses, etc. to attend hearings online. Case participants have the option to attend their hearings from the comfort of their private spaces via ZOOM. Participants without internet access can visit the Housing Court on the 3rd floor of the Justice Center and sign in with a Housing Court Bailiff on the date of their scheduled

court hearing. Until further notice, hearings will be conducted inside a remote space via ZOOM

Cleveland Housing Court's Housing Clinic

For the safety of our staff and visitors our Housing Clinic is now located on the first floor of the Justice Center weekdays from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. Additionally, you can access forms and other information by visiting our website at clevelandmunicipalcourt.org/housingcourt/forms. You can dial 216-664-4295 to speak with a Housing Specialist for further guidance. Please allow up to 24 hours for the Specialist to return your call.

Tips to prepare for your Virtual Hearing:

- Be on time.
- Make sure you have the ZOOM App downloaded to your device.
- Mute your microphone until it is your turn to speak.
- Try your best to silence the noise when your case is called.
- Log-on 15 mins before your scheduled court hearing to ensure that the ZOOM App is running appropriately.
